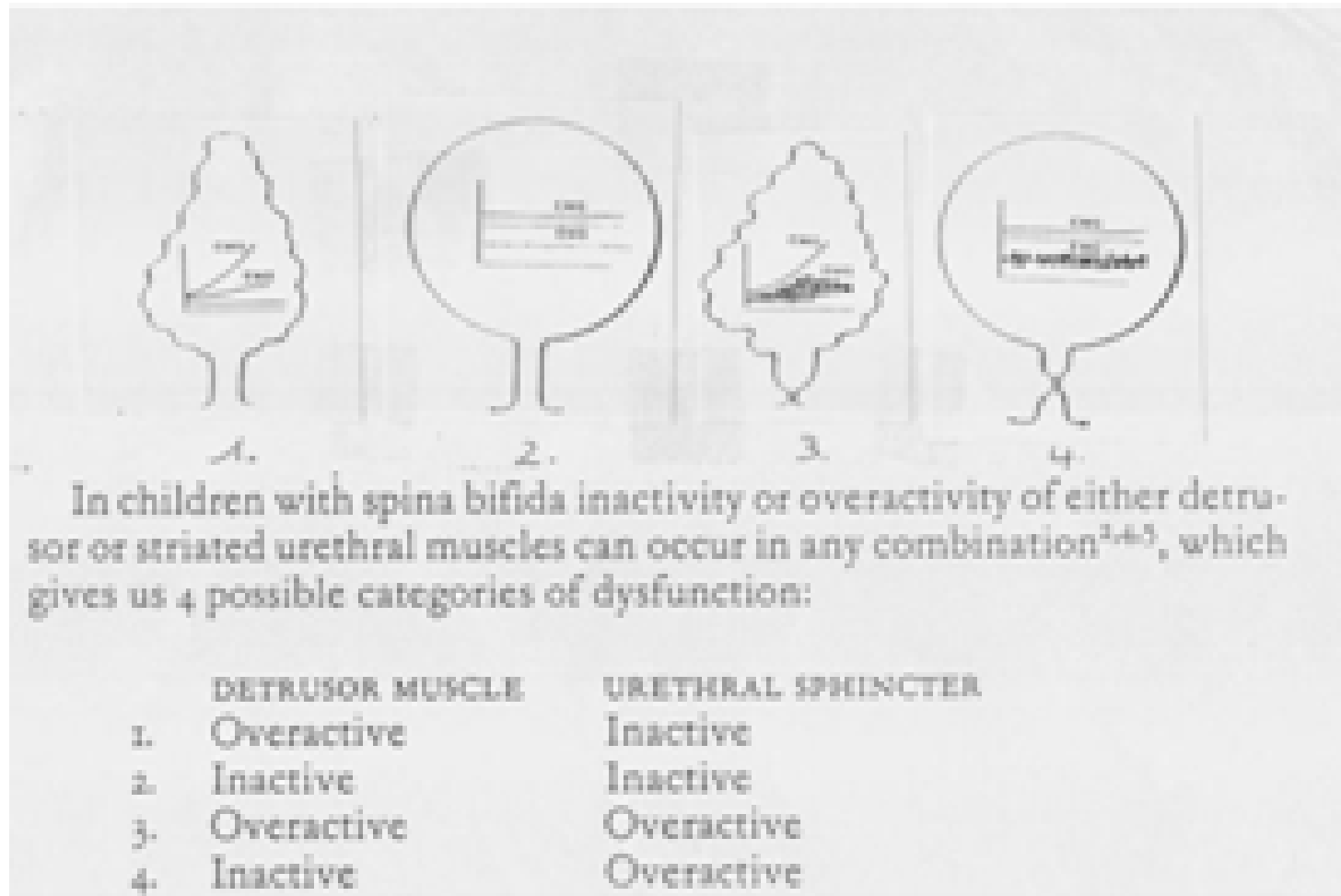
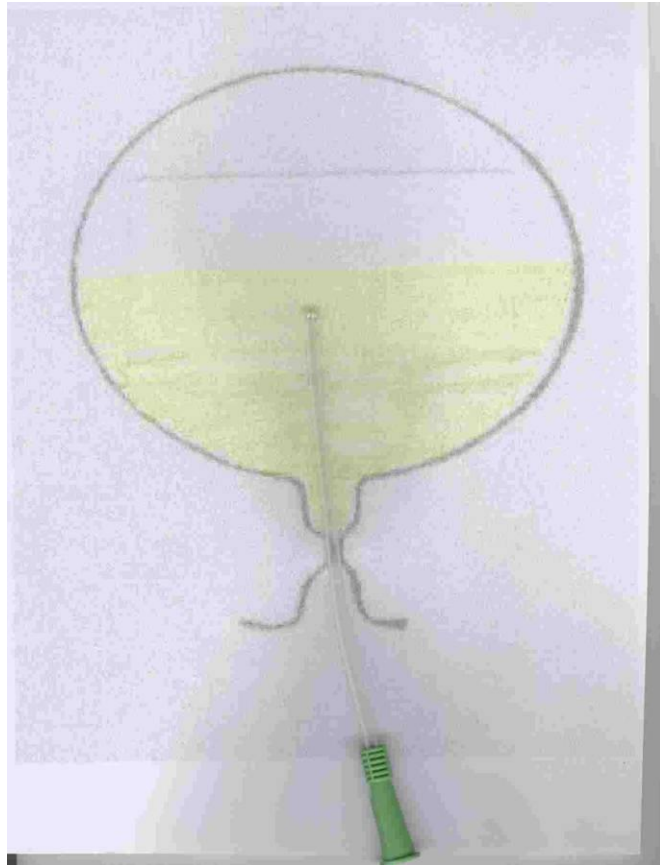


4 different neurogenic bladder types



Flacid bladder and hyperactive sfincter



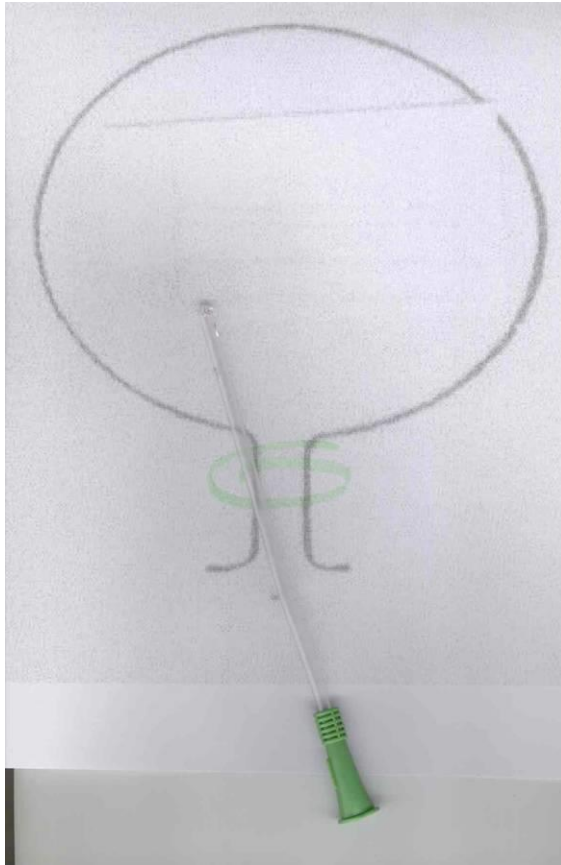
Unsafe :

- urine retention : high pressure
- Infections
- Good volumes

R/ : CIC 5x/day

dry without infections

Flacid detrusor and flacid sfincter



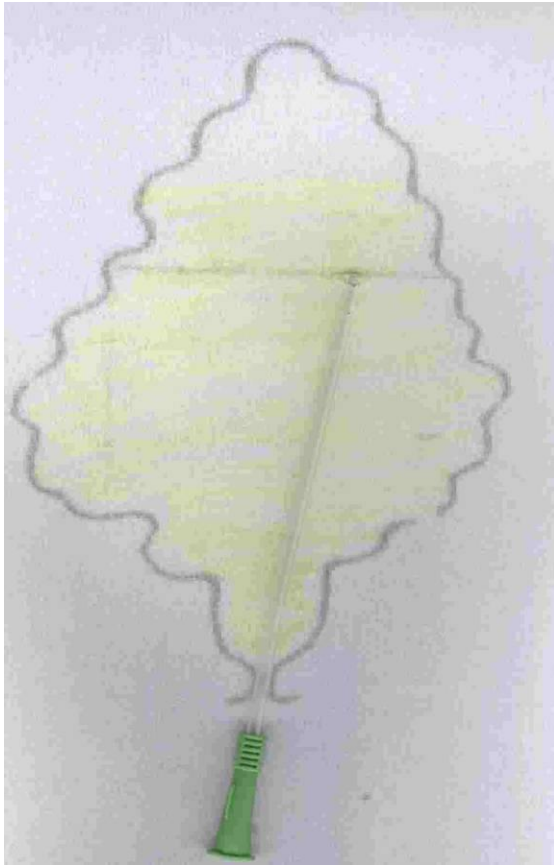
Safe

- Dribbling of urine

R/ :

- CIC to prevent infections
 - to become continent
- Sling operation +
CIC+ (Oxybutynine)

Detrusor overactivity and hyperactive sfincter

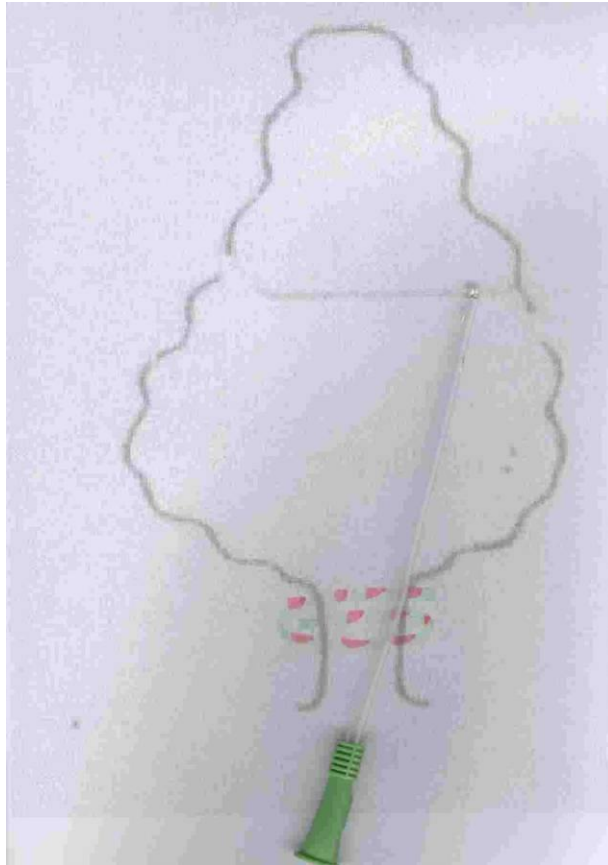


Very Unsafe :

- urine retention early in life
- high pressure
- Infections
- Bladder and kidney deterioration
- Good volumes

**R/ : CIC 5x/day +
Oxybutynine**

Hyperactive detrusor and flacid sfincter



Unsafe :

- high pressure because of bladdermuscle hypertrophy
- Infections
- Bladder and kidney deterioration later in life

R/ :

CIC 5x/day+
Oxybutynine +
sling operation
